

The antineoplastic drug administration course has a blended delivery and involves both online and face to face learning and assessment.



Online learning

The online components are accessed through the eviQ Education website <https://education.eviq.org.au/> or your facilities own learning management system (LMS).

Online components of the course include:

- 7 x modules
- 7 x eQuizzes



Face to face learning

The face to face components of the course are delivered in your local facility by a trained local facilitator (usually the educator).

Face to face components of the course include:

- supervised clinical practice
- clinical skills workshop (optional for facilities)
- 3 x competency assessments.

Not all learners will complete all components of the course. Depending upon the level of skills required, **learners will be able to exit the course at 3 distinct points.**

Exit point 1

This exit point is appropriate for all staff who require knowledge and skill only in the safe handling of antineoplastic drugs and related waste safely e.g. allied health staff.

Staff exiting the course at this point are required to:

- complete module 1
- gain 100% pass mark in the module 1 eQuiz
- complete the first competency assessment (safe handling).

Order of learning

1. Learners should first complete the module 1 eLearning guide and eQuiz online. If accessing these through the website, learners should print off their eQuiz results page as proof of completion.
2. Upon completion of these online components, learners should approach their local facilitator to complete any supervised clinical practice and their competency assessment.
3. A certificate of completion will be awarded by the local facilitator upon successful completion of the competency assessment.

Exit point 2

This exit point is appropriate for all staff who require knowledge and skill in the administration of antineoplastics via the oral route only.

Staff exiting the course at this point are required to:

- complete modules 1-6
- gain 100% pass mark in the eQuizzes for modules 1-6
- complete the first two competency assessments (safe handling and administration of orals).

Order of learning

1. Learners should first complete the module 1 eLearning guide and eQuiz online. If accessing these through the website, learners should print off their eQuiz results page as proof of completion.
2. Upon completion of these online components, learners should approach their local facilitator to complete any supervised clinical practice and their first competency assessment (safe handling).
3. A certificate of completion will be awarded by the local facilitator upon successful completion of the competency assessment.
4. Learners should then complete the eLearning guide and eQuizzes for modules 2-6 and print off all eQuiz results pages.
5. Upon completion of these online components, learners should approach their local facilitator to complete the clinical skills workshop (if offered), their supervised clinical practice and their second competency assessment (oral administration).
6. A second certificate of completion will be awarded by the local facilitator upon successful completion of the competency assessment.

Exit point 3

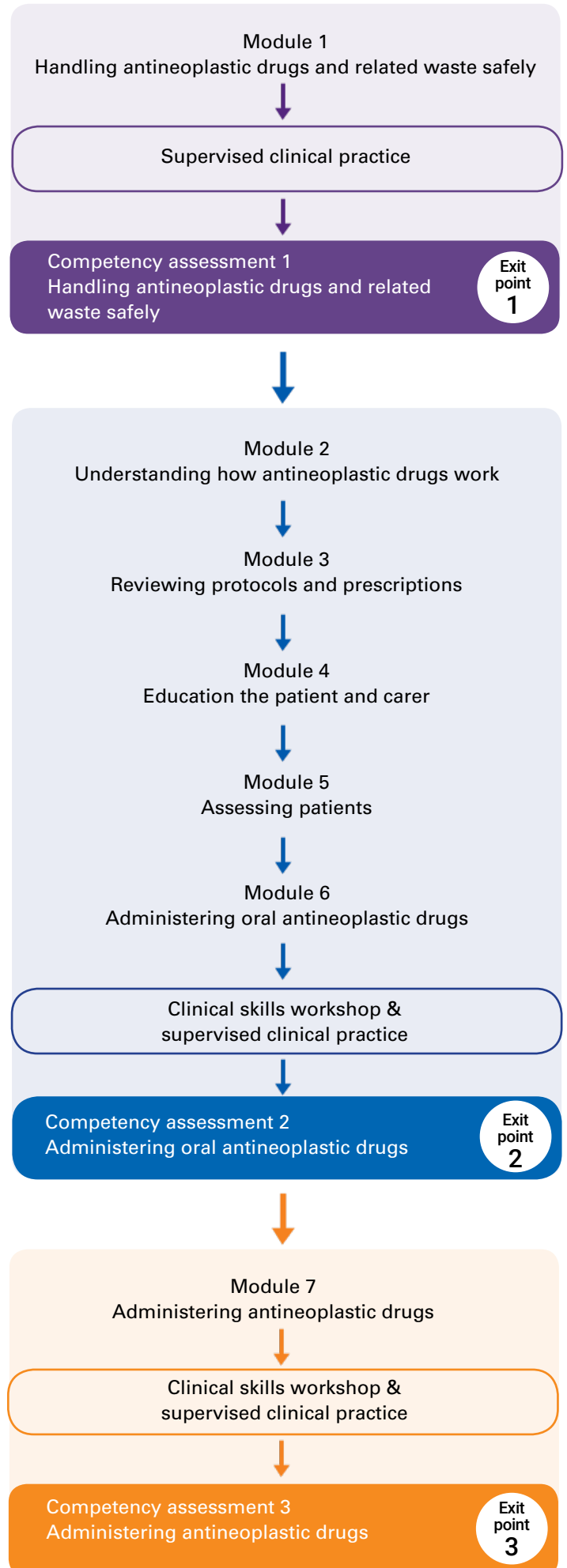
This exit point is appropriate for all staff who require knowledge and skill in the administration of antineoplastics via the IV route (and any other routes).

Staff exiting the course at this point are required to:

- complete modules 1-7
- gain 100% pass mark in the eQuizzes for modules 1-7
- complete all three competency assessments (safe handling, administration of orals, administration via IV).

Order of learning

1. Learners should first complete the module 1 eLearning guide and eQuiz online. If accessing these through the website, learners should print off their eQuiz results page as proof of completion.
2. Upon completion of these online components, learners should approach their local facilitator to complete any supervised clinical practice and their first competency assessment (safe handling).
3. A certificate of completion will be awarded by the local facilitator upon successful completion of the competency assessment.
4. Learners should then complete the eLearning guide and eQuizzes for modules 2-7 and print off all eQuiz results pages.
5. Upon completion of these online components, learners should approach their local facilitator to complete the clinical skills workshop (if offered), their supervised clinical practice and their second and third competency assessments (oral administration and IV administration).
6. A second and third certificate of completion will be awarded by the local facilitator upon successful completion of the competency assessments.



1 Online learning

Accessed through the eviQ Education website <https://education.eviq.org.au/> or your facilities own learning management system (LMS).

To satisfy requirements of the online learning components for the course learners must:

- complete all required eLearning guides
- gain a 100% passmark in all required eQuizzes.

Print off or keep a copy of all eQuiz results pages if accessing the course through the eviQ Education website.

2 Workplace learning

Once you have completed the online learning components you should approach your local facilitator to determine whether you will participate in a clinical skills workshop and/or supervised clinical practice.

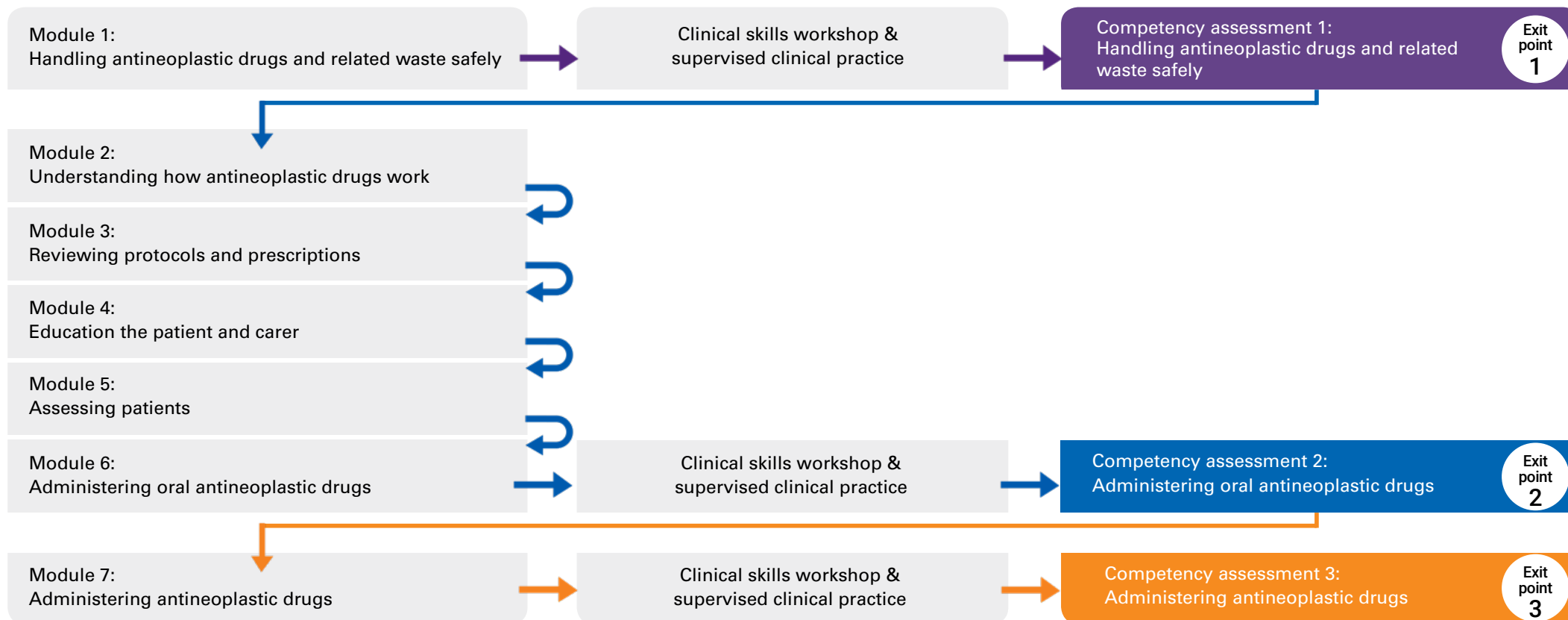
Workplace learning may be offered after completion of module 1, module 6 and module 7.

3 Competency assessment

Once you have completed any workplace learning components you should approach your local facilitator to attempt your competency assessment.

Competency assessment may be required after completion of module 1, 6 and 7 depending upon your exit point.

Your facilitator will award you a certificate of completion after successful completion of each competency assessment. Ensure you keep a copy of these. eviQ Education does not store certificates of completion.



Exit point 1 Staff who require knowledge and skill only in the safe handling of antineoplastic drugs and related waste safely. Complete all tasks with purple arrows.

Exit point 2 Staff who require knowledge and skill in the administration of antineoplastics via the oral route only. Complete all tasks with purple and blue arrows.

Exit point 3 Staff who require knowledge and skill in the administration of antineoplastics via the IV route (and any other routes). Complete all tasks (purple, blue and yellow arrows).
