

Signs and symptoms of Brain metastases and associated complications

The symptoms caused by brain metastases depend on their location and may include:



Headache is the most common symptom, often described as a tension headache which is worse in the early morning and improves during the day.



Nausea and vomiting



Seizures - more common with multiple brain metastasis



Speech difficulties



Motor and sensory deficits



Unsteady gait



Cognitive decline



Personality changes



Decreased or loss of consciousness - often due to intracranial haemorrhage.



Cardiovascular compromise (tachycardia with hypotension)
